HISTORY

The Legado West site is bound on the north by Ocotillo Road and the Trilogy Community in the Town of Gilbert, on the south by the Brooks Farm subdivision in Unincorporated Maricopa County, by undeveloped Sossaman Farm land on the east and on the west by residences in Dorada Estates and unincorporated Maricopa County. Conditions that are unique to this property include the location of the Sonoqui Wash that runs through the property, the location of the property at the intersection of two major arterial roads, the multi-jurisdictional boundaries surrounding the property and the variety of lot sizes and densities found in the adjacent properties.
